

# COVID-19 Second Booster Shot Information

Staying up-to-date on your COVID-19 vaccinations is the best way to protect yourself against severe illness and death, including highly contagious variants.

You are eligible to get a second booster shot **4 months** after your first booster shot if you are:

- 50 years and older
- 18 years and older if you received a Johnson & Johnson vaccine or booster shot
- 12 years and older with certain immunocompromised conditions
