How We Can Help:

- Care coordination support such as scheduling appointments, arranging transportation, or filling prescriptions
- Make connections to community resources (i.e., food, housing, basic needs, immigration legal services, mental health, developmental services)
- Provide translation in Pashto and Dari Farsi
- Connection to community resources, culturally sensitive health education classes, school reintegration and accommodations
- \checkmark Shared care planning with families to ensure health goals are met
- / Linkage of children in the community to medical homes and sub-specialists
